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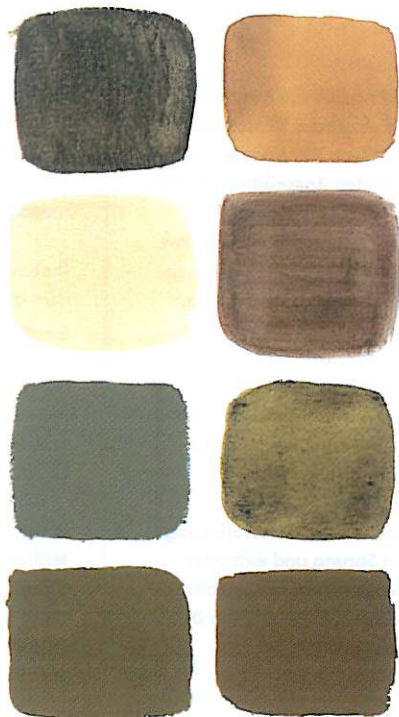
THE KNIT ISSUE

VERA PELLE ITALIANA CONCIATA AL VEGETALE: SCIROCCO

This palette is inspired by restless nomadic travel, exotic spices, archaic music, eroded surfaces and desert sands. Ecological values such as sustainable commerce, bio integrity and fair trade are key, symbolised by tribal icons, limited edition pieces and irregular surfaces.

Colours are warm, baked and sun-bleached, while exaggerated natural grains such as buffalo, camel and lama also feature. A warm metallic glow can be seen throughout the palette, with aged alloys of copper and bronze complementing a range of natural tannic colours and softened spicy tones.

Bold print stories and vibrant colour blocking are realised in this palette. Here, freshness is key – highlighted by the palette's bright tones – while glossy textures and clean surfaces reference moulded and futuristic home furnishings.

With a nod towards the 60s, influence comes from retro Scandinavian design, including the bold clean colours and lines of Danish glassware and Swedish furniture, together with the geometric patterns of wallpaper and textile design. The outcome is quirky, slick and positively adventurous.
